The Historically Black College Alumni, Inc. (HBCA) sponsors the tour for the sole purpose of promoting higher education. **Students must submit this application, essay, school transcript and two letters of recommendation from a school administrator and complete an interview.** The interview will be scheduled after all required documents are received. Any high school student age 18 and under is eligible. **The college tour includes mandatory workshops. Students who fail to attend the workshops may be disqualified from the tour.**
